Without an ID, a homeless person cannot get a job, rent a room, enter a shelter or receive most social services – creating an insurmountable barrier to returning to self-sufficiency.

IDignity will bring together the DMV, Social Security, Seminole Vital Statistics and Legal Advocacy to serve more than 120 homeless adults and their children. We need volunteers to help us!
